Have in mind the following recommendations before making your video:

1. Be creative and original in your video: ¡Do not let people forget your video!
2. Remember that some participants may not be familiar with your institution or process, try using a simple language as your addressing a non-technical audience.
3. With the purpose that you keep the audience attention, do not exceed a maximum time of 3 minutes for your video.
4. Use graphics, images, animations and other tools that help the audience understand better the work you have been doing as a group.
5. You may use the following questions as a guide:
 - a) For how long have you been working as a group?
 - b) Were the biggest challenges when you were starting?
 - c) Which have been your most relevant achievements?
 - d) What is your projection as a group?
